TEST TO STAY & LEARN
Close contacts will be tested each morning during the COVID incubation window to ensure they are not carrying the virus.

QUARANTINE
If you do not want to test daily, you will need to quarantine at home according to KDHE protocol for close contacts.

GO HOME.
In order to return to school, you must be symptom free and present a negative PCR test result or isolate in accordance with KDHE guidelines.

TEST TO STAY & LEARN
The health office will provide testing for COVID or influenza as indicated.

GO HOME.
Return time will be dependent on symptoms and will be determined in collaboration with the school nurse.

RETURN TO CLASS

GO HOME.
In order to return to school, you must present a negative PCR test result collected within 48 hrs of the original antigen result or isolate in accordance with KDHE guidelines.

RETURN TO CLASS

GO HOME.
Remain at home according to protocol for illness identified.

*Close contact is defined as being within 6ft of a positive case for at least ten consecutive minutes anytime beginning two days prior to symptom onset or positive test.

In the classroom setting, students who were between 3ft and 6ft from a positive case, if both parties consistently and correctly wore masks, can be excluded from quarantine or testing.

*Students and staff who are up to date on COVID vaccinations or those who can provide documentation of COVID infection in the previous 90 days may opt out of testing and quarantine requirements as long as they remain asymptomatic.
